Enjoy seasonal blooms and color, visit our gift shop, and join guided tours or one of our many educational programs for all ages. Rotating art and nature exhibitions provide fresh and exciting ways to experience the Garden.

Tips for a Successful Garden Visit

The Garden, with its hilly terrain, offers both challenging hikes and more moderate strolls. The California Oaks Trail offers the easiest entry. Please note, due to the natural landscape of our historic quarry site, not all areas are fully accessible.

- * Bring water.
- * Wear sturdy, closed-toed shoes.
- * Please stay on the paths, and do not remove plant material.
- * Be mindful of uneven paths and slippery rocks.
- * Respect the wildlife (deer, squirrels, birds, bobcats, foxes, and rattlesnakes).
- * First aid kit available at the Welcome Center.
- * Restrooms are near the picnic area by the parking lot and in the Asian Garden near the Arbor.


